POSITIONS

We will be seeking both internal and external positions.

EXTERNAL CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY

- External candidates must hold the terminal degree of Master in Architecture or higher. Candidates with a B.Arch. AND Professional Registration would be also eligible.
- Foreign nationals must hold valid U.S. work visas prior to hire. The institution will not proceed with the candidates' visa authorization.
- External applicants selected will be offered compensation of \$7,500.00 for the semester.
- The Focus Studio is scheduled on *Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 1:45 PM to 5:05 PM* for sixteen consecutive weeks. For external candidates, studio schedule could be adjusted as long as contact hours are the same as MWF 1:45pm-5:05pm.

SUBMISSION

- 1. A Letter of Intent (two-page maximum) that introduces your design research work and interests. The letter of intent should also include a clear statement defining the proposed studio project narrative and objectives to be developed as a Focus Studio.
- 2. A Resume/current CV
- 3. A design-research portfolio (five-page maximum) illustrating examples of professional and/or academic work you have been engaged in. Examples may include but are not limited to, built projects, competition designs, prototypes, student work, and installations. If submitting work that was part of a collaborative project, please list your collaborators and clearly state your role in the project.
