I. Attendance

II. Minutes

• The Chair called for any corrections to the minutes from the April 20, 2021 GEC General Committee meeting. There were none. Jeanne Bohannon motioned to approve, and Lauren Taglialatela seconded. The minutes were approved as written.

III. Updates

- GEOG 1125 was approved by the Board of Regents and will be implemented in Spring 2022. GEOG 1102 was returned by the Board of Regents with comments and is being reworked. Both courses were designed with the goal of creating more three-credit hour options without prerequisites in the science courses for non-Stem students in Area D.
- The USG General Education redesign is still paused, and it is anticipated that there will be no movement until a permanent new chancellor is in place and that person reviews and decides on if or how it will move forward. However, KSU will still move forward with the discussion of what changes need to be made that are the best for our students but are still aligned with USG policy.
- This academic year is the inaugural year of having an Executive Committee. The Executive Committee members should be communicating outward to the colleges and any GEC advisory members with updates and pertinent information.

The General Education Council is a very important committee. The core curriculum touches every student at Kennesaw State and Areas A through E, which totals 42 credit hours, and another 18 credit hours with Area F. That is half of a typical 120 credit hour degree.

IV. New Business

- The Curriculog system has a new interface. If you need any information about it, there are resources on the cia.kennesaw.edu website, including recordings of a presentation done the beginning of August, or you can contact the Curriculog team Amy Jones and Raven Malliett.
- There are numerous resources available to you on the cia.kennesaw.edu website: updated Curriculum Guide, 2021-2022 GEC Member Resource Guide and specific GEC information is posted in D2L.
- GEC and eCore Kris DuRocher announced that she had been added to the USG RACA for eCore and they were updating the cooperative academic agreement. Previously, the KSU GEC had not been engaged in these discussions. A new

MOU was issued this summer that explicitly outlined the roles and responsibilities of an institution. KSU's GEC will be participating in reviewing eCore courses that are proposed to align with area learning outcomes.

 - Revisit revision of some learning outcomes, especially in Area C.
