Matt Marshall presented an overview of the program which is an online, 1 year, 30 credit degree. There are 9 required courses and 1 elective for which there are 3 choices. Admissions is consistent with the rest of the college and the degree program targets STEM students.

Bill Bailey offered some feedback:

- 1. Consider providing alternatives to the GRE as opposed to offering waivers for the admission criteria.
- 2. Can bridge courses be taken in parallel, and what would this look like

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- 3. Within the courses, some mention synchronous and asynchronous design, suggest to leave that out at this time.
- 4. Some of the learning outcomes do not use "action verbs" and it is suggested to adjust those to measurable outcomes such as explain, describe, etc.
- 5. In MTRE 6800, a monthly report is required, is this realistic in a 7 week course?

This feedback was offered to make sure the best possible proposal is put forward.

MA Karim: Agree that GRE alternative may be better option over offering waivers.

Tim Blumentritt: Good advising can help steer students in need of prerequisites to a path that will provide the least burden while being able to start the program.

Ian Ferguson: There are 2 pathways into the program, 1) existing students who will not need any prerequisites, and 2) other students from STEM that will not need. The goal is to not overburden students.

Matt Marshall: Background of targeted students is that they would have most prerequisites done.

Doug Moodie: Presented each course and asked for discussion.

Bill Bailey proposed to accept the courses as a bulk item and waive 2nd reading.

It was confirmed that substantive changes were not being asked for and changes such as clarifying a learning objective are acceptable at the department level since course descriptions are not being changed.

Bill Bailey amended his motion to include accepting the program proposal in addition to the bulk course approval and waive 2^{nd} reading.

MA Karim 2nd the motion

All voting members approved without dissent.

PRESENTATION

New program, PhD in Interdisciplinary Engineering, Southern Polytechnic College of Engineering & Engineering Technology- Renee Butler

An overview of the program was presented. It will be a 72 credit PhD. A comparison of peer institutions was provided. Research and coursework is split. A 3-year course map was also provided to demonstrate a clear path to graduation.

Doug Moodie asked for a timeline.

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It's currently making in various steps of curriculog, once cleared by the Dean it goes back to the curriculum office for final review before being available to the GPCC body.

Doug Moodie proposed a special meeting of the GPCC on December 9, 2020 if the entire package is to GPCC by December 2, 2020.
