Discussion ensued.

Question about NURS 4419 regarding Credit Hour Distribution – 3/4/7

Minimum field hours is 60 but they're expected to do 172 hours in the field, which is almost 3x the appropriate field hours. Concern raised around the amount of field hours happening vs. what the credit it.

Christie Emerson spoke about combining a Senior Leadership course and Senior Practicum (which had a 0/4/4 and using a 3:1 ratio for clinical experiences). That's where that came from. So, combining a 3/0/3 with a 0/4/4 to make a 3/4/7.

Nothing is changing with the hours.

Amy pulled up a Ratio Table on screen share.

Stated that a 3:1 ratio doesn't match with this. Suggested that 12 hours in the Lab field would fit better. It gets tricky when you add lecture time because of the "outside work".

We can make a change provided that it doesn't change the total number of credit hours for the course. If we change the credit hour total, then it needs to go back through the process.

Emerson clarified that they are in the field for 12 hours a week. They're at the hospital 168 total hours and we get to 180 through the lecture.

Discussion and math ensued.

Can we change the middle/Lab hour to 12.

Credit Hour Distribution changed to: 3/12/7.

Michelle brought up discussions that affect units outside of the college/unit need to be had when it affects the courses in their prerequisites.

She gave a specific example of some changes happening in CSM that affect personnel, hiring, etc. based on a proposal approved outside of their college (so it's not showing up on the Impact report or the notification occurred in Curriculog so long ago). As we move forward, think about how changes can be communicated to units outside of the proposal's home department. Perhaps it's a discussion for the joint UPCC-GPCC meetings.

Michelle requested some info from Nursing about incoming students and anticipated impact on CSM for scheduling and personnel for those courses that are prerequisites for their programs.

At 1:37pm it was discovered that we lost the quorum.

Doug Moodie amended his motion to table this package until the next meeting. **Daniel Farr seconded.**

Discussion ensued regarding replacing Kim Loomis on the Executive Committee. Jaime Cruz-Ortiz volunteered to serve as Vice-Chair.

Since the Quorum was lost, we decided that the vote will occur virtually in order for other UPCC members to be able to nominate or self-nominate.
