First discussion was suggesting that repeatable courses indicate as such in their course description. Amy Jones pointed out that this is not necessary if the repeatable courses are clear in the program outline.

Michelle brought up the Credit Hour Distribution for the IHS 4400 Directed Studies. They submitted for a "3-0-3" but if the description indicates it experiential, they should make the credit hours variable. This proposal currently doesn't allow for that.

Amy indicated that we can either pass this now as written and they can amend it later or send it back.

Michelle pointed out that if the numbers are in the "Lecture" field, then it's not a "Lab" so the description and the CHD don't really line up.

Kandice Porter pointed out that 4400 SHOULD have variable numbers in Lab and Lecture. Looks like an error.

Kandice Porter agreed that we should fix this.

Mari-Amanda stated that they modeled these proposals off of classes already in the system. Amy Jones pointed out that courses already in the system don't really get reviewed (even if they have errors from years ago) until they are up for review themselves. Some may serve as accurate examples that fall in line with policy, some may not.
