Expedited Approval Process - Kris DuRocher

Michelle apologized that the document Kris shared wasn't shared in advance with the committee and asked if we wanted to address this now or wait until April.

See document "Recommendations for Expedited Process updated 3.2.2002rev.pdf" Kris reviewed the document.

Doug asked: if a program changes a course number for a course that exists in another program, how does that *other* program get changed. Amy and Kris said this could still go through Expedited review and they can make that program change internally. Amy clarified that this is where Impact Reports come in handy. Michelle asked if the colleges are being notified of this so that they can update their internal advising documents? Amy said they are continuing to improve communications between groups. She said that when an impact report pings another unit, that communication occur between the units to ensure all are in the know about those changes. Mike said it would be great to have those items on an FYI review. Kris noted that that information is posted in an annual review document that's posted on the CIA website. Michelle pointed out that review occurred with the EC but not the entire body. Kris pulled up the website and screenshared the SmartSheet on the CIA page that shows everything approved in the previous academic year. They reviewed this document with the committee and invited folx to reach and let them know if there is any information that we'd like to see but don't see on there.

Michelle invited any other questions or concerns...

Kris continued to review the Expedited Process for Programs (same document). Michelle asked about Recommendation number 2 and if that includes "gates" for programs. Historically, in our body, there has been a lot of discussion from our body about program gates and how they impact students.

Doug Moodie pointed out that Recommendation 2 and 3 are staying the same thing. Amy pointed out that #2 and #3 are pointing out two different points. We may want to combine them into a 2a & 2b. Michelle suggested that we can vote on each recommendation.
