


- Doctoral program coordinators will be collaborating to draft a policy on dismissal from the program tied to milestones


Graduates AY 25

Academic Calendar changes

Academic Calendar Changes Coming Fall 2025

The Fall 2025, Spring 2026, and Summer 2026 academic calendars have been adjusted to start one week later than in prior years. Fall 2025 semester will begin on Monday, Aug. 18. Subsequently, the Spring 2026 and Summer 2026 semesters will also start one week later.

The changes address concerns regarding finals beginning immediately after the Thanksgiving holiday and the lack of adequate preparation time prior to the start of the spring term following the winter break. In addition, this change will better align KSU's academic calendars with the USG eCore and eMajor calendars and other USG institutions and will better serve our students.
