GRADUATE ASSISTANT FOR TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Graduate Assistant for Training and Development (GRD) at Kennesaw State University is a graduate, 10-month commitment as a live-in staff member within the Department of Housing and Residence Life. The GRD GA position is a 20-hour per week position. The GRD will work alongside professional staff to create a residential experience for our Special Interest Housing Communities (SIHCs) and overall, on-campus experience. In conjunction with professional staff, they will coordinate the administration of our SIHCs with responsibilities, and assist in the development, implementation and assessment of resident training materials. The GRD position requires a strong work ethic, a positive attitude and enthusiasm for the residential experience on a college campus. This position includes after hours time commitments that are congruent with the traditional residence life philosophies of a live-in role.

BENEFITS

Compensation includes hourly pay for 20 hours per week and fully furnished on-campus housing accommodations with utilities (may be shared with a graduate student or partner) and tuition waiver.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE

Training

- ► Sit on the Training Taskforce
