Recommended edits”

- Add “At KSU,…” to the beginning of Section 5, 5. Definitions and Acronyms.
- In Section 6, Policy, repeat the last sentence of Section 3, Scope (Who is Affected), which reads, “KSU employees and non-employees who serve in any advisory capacity to organizations are expected to report suspected instances of hazing and cooperate in any investigations or hearings concerning hazing allegations.”

In response to a question about the policy scope, Dianne Walker explained that the policy draft is specific to student-student hazing. Amy Phillips noted that hazing-like activities between employees are prohibited by Employee Handbook, Section 8.4, Conduct Guidelines.
