I. Welcome

III. President's Update

- A. Prior to meeting, Joanne sent an email to all PTF representatives asking them to update information if there was a change in the representative starting this semester.
- B. Newsletter Joanne asked representatives to please share with their department part-time faculty.
- C. Faculty Senate Joanne shared that the Faculty Senate passed a motion to send President Whitten and Provost Schwaig to convert to virtual teaching.
- D. Update Presentation to Faculty Senate on Plus/Minus grading system. Below motion passed and will be shared for individuals to take survey. "We move for the Faculty Senate to officially request that each of its senators share the KSU Report on Plus-Minus Grading with the faculty of their department and encourage participation in the Faculty Senate Grading Modality survey by all full-and part-time faculty. Senators are requested to have the KSU Report on Plus-Minus Grading and Faculty Senate Grading Modality Survey appear as an agenda item at the February department faculty meeting as well as to send both the report and survey link to all full- and part-time faculty via their department mailing list."
- E. The Faculty Senate voted to remove the number of withdrawals students could have had before a WF was recorded.
- F. Faculty Senate also approved to eliminate the keeping course evaluations open after posting of grades for this could be seen as retaliation from students after they see their grade.

IV. New Business

- A. Outstanding Part-Time Faculty Award Joanne shared information about the award previously through email to all representatives. Mandy McGrew updated representatives on process for part-time faculty and using CETL for assistance.
- B. Michael presented discussed how to use a digital background during virtual meetings. Backgrounds were uploaded to Teams and part-time faculty website for part-time faculty to download and use.
- C. Michael and James presented an overview of how to use Microsoft Teams at a basic level. The purpose of Teams is to collaborate with part-time faculty and store documents. This will be a primary place for communication outside the ListServ. Highlights of the presentation include:
