James will follow up with the parking committee. Survey results will be made available to elected representatives, but the results are not for public distribution.
- C. HB910 University and state employees K-12 will receive a \$5,000 pay raise. Part-time faculty were included in K-12. James will follow up to find out what this means for faculty who teach part-time at KSU. Representative Chuck Clay will form a committee to make a plan to address this issue.
