I. Welcome

President Michael Perry called the meeting to order @ 3:31 pm. He reviewed the goals of the Part-Time Faculty Council. He also reordered to agenda to allow for Dr. Schwaig to speak prior to the business part of the meeting.

II. Approval of Minutes

Ben Setzer made the motion to approve the minutes of the October meeting as published, and Yvonne Wichman seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as published.

III. New Business

- A. Interim Kennesaw State University President Dr. Kat Schwaig thanked President Perry for his strong leadership and spoke to the representatives. She discussed the following:
 - 1. Student Success Task Force charge to focus on increasing percentage of students who graduate in four years from 48% statewide to 18% at Kennesaw State,
 - 2. R2 Roadmap with focus on undergraduate and graduate research. Increasing research doctorates is a goal,
 - 3. Initiatives to increase community engagement,
 - 4. Addition of new staff to focus on racism and equity initiatives, and
 - 5. Capital Campaign for athletics and scholarships.
- B. President Perry had asked representatives and attendees to submit questions for Dr. Schwaig prior to the meeting. He asked Dr. Schwaig to respond to each question. answered questions from members on both topics. (The questions are attached to the minutes.) A link to the recorded meeting will be posted on the PTFC webpage.

IV. President's Update

President Michael Perry provided highlights from the Faculty Senate meeting.

- A. Shared Governance Shared governance was discussed. President Perry continued to stress that the need for part-time faculty involvement in shared governance. This has been a key goal of the PTFC.
- B. Vaccine Leave Fulltime faculty were reminded that they have eight hours of paid leave related to getting the vaccine to prevent COVID.
- C. Post Tenure Review Based on Faculty Senate recommendation, a Post-Tenure Review committee has been established. Nominations for service on the committee were requested.
- D. Withdrawal Dates Withdrawal dates for courses will revert to former policy.
- E. Motions Motions
 - 1. Change withdrawal policy to eliminate the inability of a student to withdraw from a course if money is owed to the university Passed
 - 2. Policy to have President and Provost speak at the end of a faculty Senate meeting to allow more time for faculty business Failed
 - 3. Eliminate verbal voting at Faculty Senate Failed
