I. Welcome

President Michael Perry called the meeting to order @ 3:35 pm. He previewed the items to be discussed.

II. Approval of Minutes

Yvonne Wichman made the motion to approve the minutes of the September meeting as published, and Chuck Clay seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as published.

III. President's Update

President Michael Perry provided highlights from the Faculty Senate meeting.

A. Recent changes at the USG include a move toward the end of tenure in Georgia. The discussion centered on the addition Student Success as a fourth pillar added to the current pillars of Teaching, Research, and Service. Student Success incorporates degree completion as a criterion for evaluation.

The Faculty Senate discussed drafting a letter of protest to the addition to the criteria as it is an element of student success that is not in the control of an individual faculty member. This change impacts faculty who teach part-time in terms of evaluation and retention. Additional discussion centered on the lack of data on when and why students leave programs, transfer from KSU and are considered as non-completers, and minimum GPA requirements set by BOR.

- A. Faculty Senate President Dr. Darina Lepadatu spoke to the representatives
 - 1. Discussed the The Presential Search committee. Reported that committee was composed of representatives from all shared governance groups. The ideal candidate will have a strong academic background, research experience, and have come up "through the ranks." The deadline to apply is January 10, 2022. Interviews will be scheduled for February; five names will be forwarded to the Board of Regents. Hopefully, an offer will be made in March.
 - 2. Discussed the implications of the new Student Success initiative for Tenured Faculty with a focus on how this will impact all colleges and all faculty.
 - 3. Answered questions from members on both topics.
- B. Parking Places and Fees The Executive Committee has discussed the use of surveys to gain information and determine positions of faculty who teach part-time on parking and fees. Vice-President James Stinchcomb explained the content and process for the survey. He has been assigned to represent PTFC on the parking committee.

- C. Questions for the Interim President and Provost President Perry confirmed that Dr. Kat Schwaig and Dr. Ivan Pulinkala will speak to the PTFC in November and December. He asked that faculty send questions for the President and Provost through a link provided by email to all faculty who teach part-time.
- D. Training Vice President James Stinchcomb will email the links to KSU training opportunities through UITS. Mandy McGrew reminded faculty to check CETL website.
