I'm excited to introduce Kathy 'Kat' Schwaig [SCH-WHY-G], the sixth president of Kennesaw State University. President Schwaig stepped in as interim president in 2021 and officially took the reins in 2022. Since then, KSU has truly soared. Today, KSU is an emerging top public research institution with more than 47,000 students. As President, Schwaig launched the "Taking Flight" strategic plan and the FLIGHT program to support first-year students.

Under her leadership, KSU has rolled out dozens of new and in-demand academic programs and made big investments in infrastructure. KSU has more than doubled research expenditures, seen an 81% jump in external research awards, and has increased annual fundraising by 250%.
