



**Career Consular Officials
Out of State Tuition Differential Waiver**

The Career Consular waiver may be granted to a student or their spouse and dependents who are on assignment under government orders in Georgia on a foreign diplomat personal visa living in Georgia. The student must be lawfully present in Georgia. The waiver must be renewed every 12 months provided the student is still eligible for the waiver.

Students will have until 30 days after the first day of the term to apply for this waiver. No applications will be accepted past that date. No retroactive changes will be considered for prior terms or fiscal years.

- Current verification letter or form on consulate letterhead stating that the career consular officer is a citizen of the foreign nation and that the consular office represents and is stationed to and living in Georgia under orders of the respective government.
- Front and back copy of career consular Passport, Visa, I-94, and/or EAD

If the student is the spouse and/or dependent of Career Consular Official:

One of the following (depending on situation):

- Birth certificate (the seal must be visible and legible)
- U.S. court documentation of guardianship
- Front and back copy of the student’s Passport, Visa, I-94, and/or EAD
- Marriage certificate
- Passport or Visa indicating relationship to career consular signed by student

I understand that any material false statement made knowingly and willingly by me on this application, or any documents attached hereto may, in accordance with O.C.G.A. 16-10-71, which provides that upon conviction, a person who knowingly commits the offense of false swearing shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years, or both, subject me to prosecution in a court of law. Additionally, I further understand that any such false statement may subject me to immediate dismissal from the institution.

I understand that I must notify Kennesaw State University immediately if my spouse or parent/guardian is assigned employment outside the State of Georgia. I also understand this waiver, if approved, is valid for 12 months and I must reapply for the waiver at that time.
