

PETITION TO CHANGE TUITION CLASSIFICATION

PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY BEFORE YOU COMPLETE THE PETITION

Initial tuition classification is determined by the admission application submitted by the student. A student's resident status is not changed automatically. The student is responsible for registering under the proper tuition classification. The burden of proof that the student qualifies as a legal resident under the regulations of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia (USG) rests with the student. The combination of items requested and information provided on this petition will be taken into consideration in the review to change the student's tuition classification under the provision of <u>Board of Regents Policy 4.3</u> and Georgia Code O.C.G.A. 20-3-66. The final decision rests with the Tuition Classification Officer to determine your documentation aligns with Board of Regents policy. **The petition must be filed no later than 30 days after the semester begins for the student to be considered for reclassification for that semester. If the petition is granted, reclassification will not be retroactive to prior semesters.**

A student's eligibility to be classified as a resident depends on their dependent or independent status. The chart below differentiates a dependent from an independent and requirements to be classified as a Resident. Domicile is defined as an individual's present and permanent home where they intend to stay indefinitely and to which they return following periods of temporary absence. No individual may have more than one domicile even though an individual may maintain more than one residence. Temporary residence does not constitute the establishment of domicile.

Lawful Presence Verification is required of every student requesting in-state tuition classification. This is proof that the student is lawfully present in the United States. U.S. lawful permanent residents, refugees, asylees, and other eligible noncitizens as defined by federal Title IV regulations may be extended the same consideration as U.S. citizens in determining eligibility for in-state. Information on eligible noncitizens is found in Volume 1, Chapter 2 of the <u>U.S. Department of Education's Federal Student Aid (FSA) Handbook</u>.

 A dependent student (under age 24) whose parent or U.S. court-appointed legal guardian lives in Georgia must prove their parent/US court appointed legal guardian: Moved to Georgia for reasons other than attending a post-secondary educational institution. Abandoned all ties to their previous state or country of residence. Changed their license/state ID, vehicle registration, and voter registration to Georgia. Lived in Georgia for at least 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the first day of classes. Filed a Georgia tax return as a Part Year or Full Year Resident. If they did not file a Georgia tax return, they must not be filing a return as a resident of another state. If applicable, must have US court-appointed legal guardianship signed by a US Court Judge appointed before the student's 18th birthday without the purpose to pay in-state tuition. 	 An independent (under age 24 but financially self-sustaining OR age 24 or older) student must prove: Moved to Georgia for reasons other than attending a post-secondary educational institution. Abandoned all ties to their previous state or country of residence. Changed their license/state ID, vehicle registration, and voter registration to Georgia. Lived in Georgia for at least 12 continuous months immediately preceding the first day of classes. Filed a Georgia tax return as a Part Year or Full Year Resident. If they did not file a Georgia tax return, they must not be filing a return as a resident of another state. Receives no financial assistance from outside of Georgia. If under age of 24, is not claimed as a dependent on taxes of their parent/guardian residing outside of Georgia. If under age of 24, earns a minimum yearly income of \$15,650 (US Dept. of HHS, 2025). 		
We highly recommend you email us to determine if you really need to petition before submitting documentation. If we have already told you to petition then you should proceed to complete this form and submit the required documentation. Please attach copies of the following documents as required evidence of residence. Once petition and documents are received, a review will be completed within seven (7) business days. The decision will be sent to your KSU student e-mail. If denied, you will also be given information on your appeal rights.

- 1. Georgia Driver's License(front and back)
 - a. If dependent, also submit parent/guardian's license
- 2. Georgia Vehicle Registration Form
 - a. If dependent, also submit your parent/guardian's vehicle registration
- 3. Georgia State Income Tax Return (GA form 500) for most recent tax year including the Electronic Declaration page or handwritten signature on the last page of the tax return.
 - a. If dependent, submit your parent/guardian's Georgia State Income Tax Return
- 4. Proof of Employment: Choose at least one of the following. *If under 24 and proving independent status, your documentation must show your wages and pay frequency to prove you are earning over the federal poverty level.
 - a. Letter from employer, on letterhead, verifying current employment
 - b. Most recent paystub
- 5. Proof of housing for the 12 months preceding the first day of the term as defined as:

Spring Semester: January to January; *Summer Semester:* May to May; Fall Semester: August to August Submit any combination of the documents below to document this period.

- a. Warranty deed
- b. Off campus apartment or home rental agreement
- c. Notarized statement from the property owner stating the address and date you moved in
- d. Utility or mortgage bill from the first and last month of the 12-month period
- 6. If US Citizen, Georgia Voter Registration Card. Find your card on the <u>Georgia My Voter Page</u>.
- 7. If you are not a US Citizen, the front and back of your Permanent Resident card or other immigration documents to show your status.
- 8. If you have a US court-appointed legal guardian, court documents verifying guardianship
- 9. If under the age of 24 and petitioning as an independent student, you must submit:
 - a. Your parent/guardian's most recent Federal Tax Return
 - b. Notarized statement testifying that they did not and will not claim you as a dependent on their tax return while you are attending KSU, and do not provide any financial support. This also applies if your parent/guardian lives in another country.
 - c. If you are unable to contact your parents or they are deceased, provide a notarized statement explaining your circumstances as to why your parents are unable to provide documentation.
